Course Information

Course Overview

Children with single ventricle anatomy are among the most complicated and challenging patients encountered. Their unique cardiac anatomy requires an understanding of their hemodynamics and the specialized care they require. This one-day conference will provide continuing education on exciting and innovative advancements as well as the nursing care of the single ventricle patient. The presentations will address topics spanning from the pre/post-op phases of the patient as well as the long-term complications and outpatient management. The conference is directed towards nurses, advanced practice nurses and other medical staff that care for this pediatric population.

General Information

The conference will be held in the Ruth and Tristram Colket, Jr. Translational Research Building. The registration fee is \$100 and includes continental breakfast, breaks, lunch, parking and syllabus material.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course, participants should be able to:

- Identify essential components of care of the single ventricle patient
- Identify surgical repairs and treatments for the single ventricle patient
- Understand complications associated with single ventricle patients in the pre-op and post-op period
- Understand outpatient and long-term care of the single ventricle patient
