# Course Information

## Course Overview

This course is for general pediatricians, pediatric specialists, nurses, nurse practitioners and any healthcare team members with an interest in pediatric solid organ transplantation. It is a one-day lecture format course highlighting issues that span all pediatric solid organ transplantation. In addition to scheduled lectures, there will also be opportunities to interact with course faculty.

## Course Objectives

1. Review the process of solid organ transplantation from candidate recognition to organ procurement and distribution.
2. Define immune tolerance and recognize what techniques are being used to reduce the use of corticosteroids for immune suppression.
3. Recognize the challenges facing the patient and family following solid organ transplantation.

The conference will be held Thursday, April 15, 2010, at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia's Leonard and Madlyn Abramson Pediatric Research Center.
