The Poison Control Center offers the public information regarding poisons and poisoning, including providing information pertaining to potential exposure to environmental chemicals. In some instances, families or health care providers seek additional expertise and evaluation for environmental toxicology concerns.

There are a limited number of physicians qualified to provide special medical consultation regarding exposures to environmental or occupational chemicals and pollutants. These may include medical toxicologists, or specialists in occupational and environmental medicine.
