The organizing committee invites you to submit an abstract for poster presentation at the
Fourth International Nursing Conference on Children and Adolescent Cancer Survivorship.

Abstract Selection Process

1. Abstracts will only be accepted for review until **January 15, 2010**.
2. Program committee will select abstracts for poster and oral presentation based on compliance with abstract criteria, merits of the abstract, over all symposium curriculum focus and constraints of the program.
3. All authors will be notified by email of abstract acceptance or decline by **February 26, 2010**.
4. Plenary Session: The top abstracts submitted will be accepted for a 20-minute oral, slide presentation.
5. Poster Session: Authors are expected to be at their posters to present them and answer questions on **June 9, 2010 from 4:15 to 6:00 pm.**
6. The decision of the review committee regarding acceptance of abstracts is final.
7. Once accepted, abstracts will be published in the final program booklet and scheduled for either oral or poster presentation.

Abstract Review Process

1. Abstracts will be distributed to the program committee in a blind author format.
2. If based on project or program, the implementation and outcome phase must be completed.
3. Research abstracts must be correctly formatted: Purpose, Design, Setting, Methods, Results and Conclusion.
4. Research abstract submitted with IRB documents when applicable.
5. Best Practice abstracts must be correctly formatted: Topic, Implementation, Outcomes and Recommendations.
6. Abstracts may not have any identifying information in them inclusive of name, hospital or trauma system.

Submission Process

1. Go to www.chop.edu/cme and click on the **Fourth International Nursing Conference on Children and Adolescent Cancer Survivorship** abstract guidelines.
2. Email your abstract as a word attachment to **Wendy Hobbie** at hobbie@email.chop.edu. The file name of the attachment must include the abstract title and main author's last name. In the body of the email, please include your complete contact information.

4. There are no abstract forms. Please use plain 8.5" x 11" white paper, follow abstract format guidelines and submit by the final copy via email to: hobbie@email.chop.edu
5. Please indicate your presentation preference: Oral Poster No preference Roundtable

PLEASE NOTE: by submitting this abstract you are acknowledging that one of the listed authors will be present at the conference to represent the poster at the conference. Submitting an abstract does not register you for the meeting.

Format Guidelines

1. Use font size 12 point, Arial or Times New Roman.
2. One page in length, single spaced with a limit of 300 words.
- 2a. For roundtable submission, limit of 200 words.
3. Abstract must be submitted with a cover sheet containing the Abstract Title, Author(s) and contact information.
4. Abstracts must be written in English.
5. Use a concise title (use all CAPITAL letters).
6. List affiliations of author(s) as briefly as possible with NAME, DEGREE, HOSPITAL, CITY, STATE and COUNTRY.
7. The presenter's name must be underscored.
8. Use standard and well-accepted abbreviations.
9. Abstract content should be typed in lowercase and contain the purpose of study, summarized description of project, results and conclusions.
