

Approved Items in the NICU

Approved Items in the NICU:

You may bring these items from home or the NICU may provide you with these items, ask your nurse or developmental team member for any that you need

Wipeable plastic/silicone toys such as but not limited to: Rattles, Teethers, Mobiles with wipeable plastic parts (a team member can discuss baby's readiness with you)



Muslin & receiving swaddle/blankets



Clothing such as but not limited to: onesies, hats, socks, bows, scent cloths etc.



Sleep Sack

Religious/ spiritual items

*Items will be placed in a plastic sleeve to protect from dust. You can also request a chaplain for more discussion.

Wipeable battery operated music/sound machine

Breastfeeding pillow: covers must be laundered weekly



Family pictures, Books, Picture frames, Sibling artwork, name signs etc.

*Items will be enclosed in a plastic sleeve upon arrival to NICU

Items that are not allowed in the NICU:

All items listed below can increase the risk for infection or safety hazards

Stuffed/plush animals: Loveys, plush pacifier holders, beanie babies, wood items etc.



Plush/Fleece/Knit blankets



Knit/Crochet Octopus



Weighted Blankets or Pillows

Mobiles with plush toys



Balloons or Live Plants/ Flowers



Heating pads

Anything with Cords/plugs/electronics/ portable (battery) fans

*Ipads/cell phones are not allowed in cribs

* Ask your nurse or developmental team for information about hospital approved seating
