



<b>Other Name:</b>	Fluticasone
Type of Medicine:	Antiinflammatory Corticosteroid Control medicine for everyday
Why you need it:	To decrease swelling and mucus in the airways
How it is given:	Inhaler (puffer) with a spacer
Side effects:	Stuffy nose Infection in mouth

## **Tips for Taking**

- 1. Shake before using.
- 2. Store in a cool dry place.
- 3. Rinse mouth after taking.
- 4. Must be taken everyday, even when your child feels okay.
- 5. It may take 2 or more weeks to see a change in your child's asthma.
