

## Pediatric Oncology/Stem Cell Transplant Inpatient and Outpatient Hospitalist

The Division of Oncology at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia is currently seeking a full-time Pediatric Hematology/Oncology trained hospitalist to join our team in a hybrid position covering both inpatient and outpatient areas.

When outpatient, the hospitalist acts as an independent attending in our late clinic (afternoon/evenings) caring for patients in both the oncology and day medicine clinic, receiving transfusions, chemotherapy, infusions, and sick visits.

They would also serve as a Charge Doctor and procedurist throughout the year.

When inpatient, oncology hospitalists provide coverage for children in conjunction with a subspecialty oncology attending, as well as acting in a full attending role on service for inpatient teams several weeks a year.

This position would also be a candidate for an Adjunct Faculty title at University of Pennsylvania after an initial evaluation period and completion of any required onboarding and orientation processes.

- Post fellowship and board certified or board eligible in pediatric hematology/oncology
