## HOW TO COMMUNICATE WITH CHOP FOR CONSULTATIONS AND PATIENT CARE





To enhance communications with our partners, there are two convenient ways healthcare partners can communicate with Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP), depending on your patient's situation.

**1.** Do you have a clinical question about a patient who has not been seen by a CHOP subspecialist?

Do you want to have a conversation about whether specialty care is the best next step?

Try our Clinical Priority Phone Line.

Call 1-800-TRY-CHOP (1-800-879-2467) and press 2 to be connected with a clinician in the subspecialty you specify. Please do not use this line for ongoing medical management. To facilitate this conversation, please provide a cell number for the clinician who is requesting the conversation. If providing a secondary (backline) number, we don't want you to miss the call back from the specialist! Please let your staff know that you are expecting a call-back.

**2.** Do you have a transport or referral request? Do you need medical advice or assistance with a complex patient being sent to the CHOP Emergency Department?

Contact our Enterprise Medical Command Physician.

Call the Transport Communications Center at **215-590-2160** and ask to be connected with the Enterprise Medical Command Physician (E-MCP).

Who are we? CHOP pediatric emergency medicine physicians

Where are we? Working in CHOP's Mission Control Center or remotely

## What is our role?

- Be the initial decision-maker for transport or referral requests from outside hospitals and referring clinicians
- Direct the routing of patients to CHOP's Philadelphia Campus, King of Prussia Campus and affiliate/network hospitals

- Help the CHOP enterprise with capacity management and patient flow
- Consult with referring clinicians who need medical advice or assistance with complex patients being sent to the ED
- Be a resource for clinicians at outside hospitals for patients "paused" during Transport Selective Mode
- Provide clinical support for CHOP transport teams at outside hospitals and en route back to CHOP
