The Diabetes Center at CHOP is enhancing its team approach to care. Each family will pick a team — based on the day, location or providers you prefer. Your appointments will be every three months with the same team of care providers. Our full-service, team-based approach will help you manage your diabetes and achieve your personal best.

Each team will have: an endocrinologist, a nurse practitioner, a certified diabetes educator (CDE), a social worker, a dietitian and our psychologist.

There are several advantages to the team approach:

- You will have on-site access to all of the members of the team in the same place to help you use new technology and problem-solve the issues you're facing and to give you the latest information available for achieving good diabetes control.
- Communication among members of the team will be improved since they will work together every day.
- You will be able to schedule appointments with your team more easily.
- Your team will work together with you and your family to make sure you are as healthy as you can be.
- Your team will evaluate your diabetes control with a HbA1c blood test and perform other routine screening tests recommended by the American Diabetes Association.
- You will see the dietitian and CDE at least once a year.
